



So, we can conclude that "fame" is not a reliable reference to measure the quality and relevance of the work of an artist.




How to measure the quality and relevance of the work of an artist for the art world without considering the "fame" in the formula?






What makes an artist "good"?
Or, how "good" the work of an artist is?














PTI is a reference model which measures the relevance and the quality of the work of a visual artist. It represents the conjunction of knowledge in art and taste ("the educated eye") of a representative number of players in the art world















Gathering Artist Information

The ODBK team checks and gathers information from the artist



Evaluation Process

Each evaluator receive a link to make the evaluation for the artist using the ODBK website.



Requirement to ODBK / AMARC

A call for Pure Taste Indicator calculation is made from a page on the ODBK website



Evaluators selection

The Pure Taste Indicator selects the team of evaluators randomly from the AMARC database




Pure Taste Indicator calculation and results publication

Using the Pure Taste Indicators formulas created by DHadmann the result is calculated and published on the ODBK website

Referendum

A **referendum** is a direct vote in which an entire electorate is invited to vote on a particular proposal.

Demarchy

This is the selection of political officials as a random sample from a larger pool of candidates, a system intended to ensure that all competent and interested parties have an equal chance of holding public office.




The Pure Taste Indicator Mechanism

AMARC Levels of expertise

In construction:

How to define the level of expertise? System is based on a point system

- Tests of knowledge
- Attendances to biennales curatorial work, papers, research





The Pure Taste Indicator Advantages / Benefits / Possibilities

- Removes hidden variables of the current system of the art world
- Increase the number of people who influence the decisions that define the art world
- Discovering of new values in the art world
- A fairer distribution of money and opportunities
- Build an example of how alternative economic models can help to distribute homogeneously the wealth and opportunities



The Pure Taste Indicator Disadvantages / Obstacles


- Require a lot of resources to get the information to build the calculations
- The estimation of the evaluators could potentially not be honest and/or precise
- The referendum model could present the lack of homogeneity of the evaluation groups, and lack of control of preferences oriented evaluations (friends and family of artists who evaluates the artist not objective)
- A difference in art education and experience of the evaluators
- Evaluators cannot see the works live, causing potential problems with installations and 3d works


